- Photo chemicals
- TVs, CRTs, electronics
- Fire extinguishers

From the Workbench

- Adhesive, glue, resins
- Lighter fluid
- Oil base paints
- Paint strippers/thinners
- Sealants
- Solvents, varnishes
- Wood preservatives

WHAT NOT TO BRING: Ammunition, fireworks, explosives; asbestos; butane, other flammable gases; commercial/industrial waste; compressed gas cylinders (propane tanks accepted); construction materials; empty aerosol cans (can go in recycling); empty containers; infectious/biological wastes; latex paint (latex paint can be dried out and placed next to trash w/cover off); non-hazardous materials; polychlorinated biphenyl (PCBs); prescription medicines (may be taken to police station); radioactive waste.
